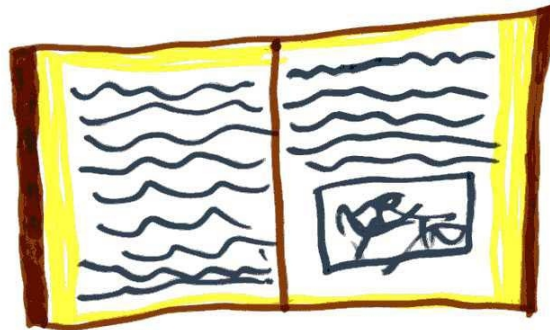

## **Chinatown Master Plan 2010 Youth Art Contest**

Chinatown Master Plan 2010 is hosting a Youth Art Contest. The contest is open to youth from ages 6 to 21. Winners of the Youth Art Contest will have their artwork published in material to promote the Chinatown Master Plan 2010. The Chinatown Master Plan 2010 is a project led by a collaboration of community members, community-based organizations, institutions, and local businesses to update the Chinatown master plan. The Chinatown Master Plan 2010's goal is to guide the development of Chinatown and ensure its socio-economic and cultural vitality.

Contest entrants should submit an original artwork that displays the contestant's vision of what Chinatown could or should be in the future. For example, artwork can pertain to a safer Chinatown, a Chinatown with more parks and open space, more places to hang out, or more shopping. All artwork must adhere to the contest rules and artwork guidelines.

### **Contest Rules**

1. Artwork submission must be an original creation and the work of the contestant.
2. Contestants must fill out the entry form to enter the contest.
3. Contestants must be a Massachusetts resident or enrolled in school in Massachusetts, and contestants must submit entries to the appropriate age group:
  - a. Group 1: Ages 6-11
  - b. Group 2: Ages 12-15
  - c. Group 3: Ages 16-21
4. Only one entry per contestant will be accepted. If more than one entry is submitted, only one entry will be judged.
5. Artwork must display the contestant's vision of what Chinatown could or should be in the future. Contestants should attach a brief description of the art submission.
6. Contestants must send a hard copy of the original artwork.
7. Contestants will retain copyrights to their artwork, but CMP2010 reserves the right to display, publish, and make work available to the public.
8. Artwork submitted to the contest will not be returned.
9. The Chinatown Master Plan 2010 reserves the right to reject any entry.
10. There is NO ENTRY FEE.

### **Artwork Guidelines**

1. Contestants should write their name on the back of their artwork.
2. Artwork should show the contestant's vision of what Boston Chinatown could or should be in the future. Think about who will be living, working and playing in the neighborhood, what kinds of activities will take place there, and what it will look like – identify any features that make Chinatown special.

3. Eligible entries must be one of the following: drawing/sketch, painting, design created with an art software/program, or photography.
4. Artwork must be produced on material that can be easily reproduced (i.e. paper, canvas).
5. Entries must be at least 3” by 5” and no larger than 30” by 50”.

### **Judging and Prizes**

1. A total of 6 winners will be selected. A first and second place winner will be selected from each of the three age groups
  - a. 1<sup>st</sup> Place: \$75
  - b. 2<sup>nd</sup> Place: \$25
2. The Chinatown Master Plan 2010 Oversight Committee will act as the judges for the contest. The Oversight Committee will meet in between April and May 2010 to review submissions and select winners from each age group.
3. Judges will select the best pieces of artwork based on the following criteria:
  - a. Creativity
  - b. Originality
  - c. Artistic quality

### **Schedule and Deadlines**

1. Submission deadline: April 15, 2010. Entries must be postmarked or dropped off by 5pm.
2. July 2010: winners will be contacted and announced at Chinatown Master Plan public meeting and selected artworks will be displayed.
